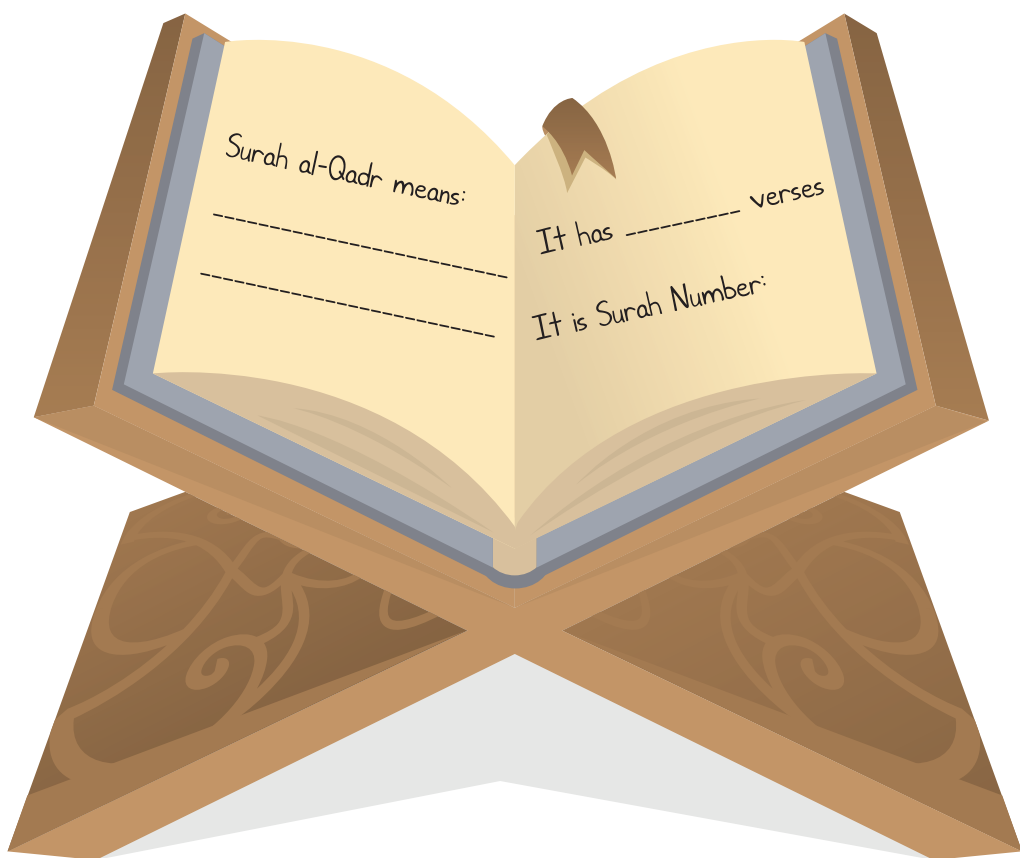

Astaghfirullah wa atoobu ilayh'

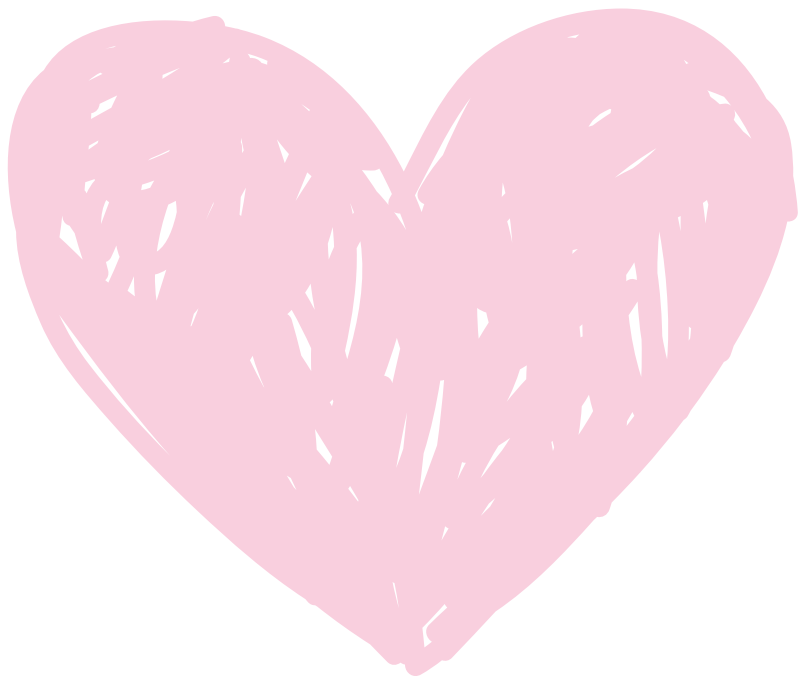

By always being aware of my actions and doing good deeds

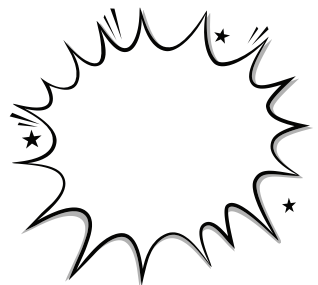
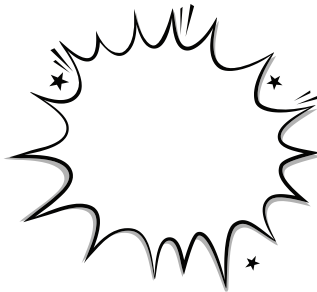
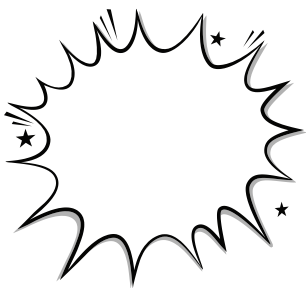
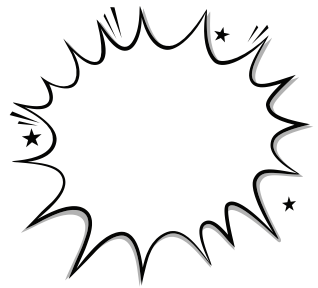
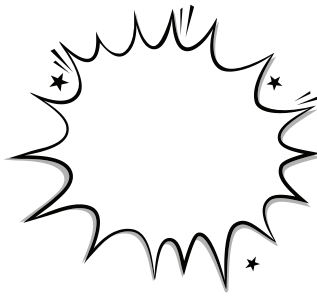
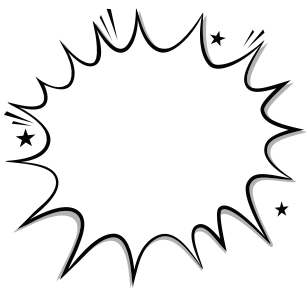
